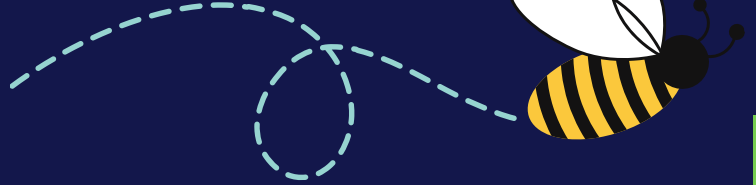

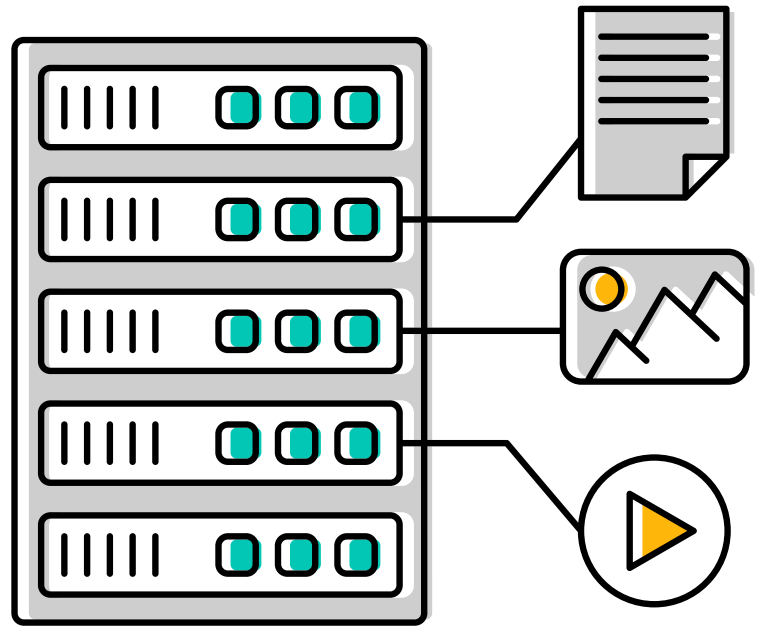
Buzzwords in Education Explained

APK

(ACTIVATE PRIOR KNOWLEDGE)

A cognitive learning strategy to prompt learners to bring forth information that they already know about a topic.



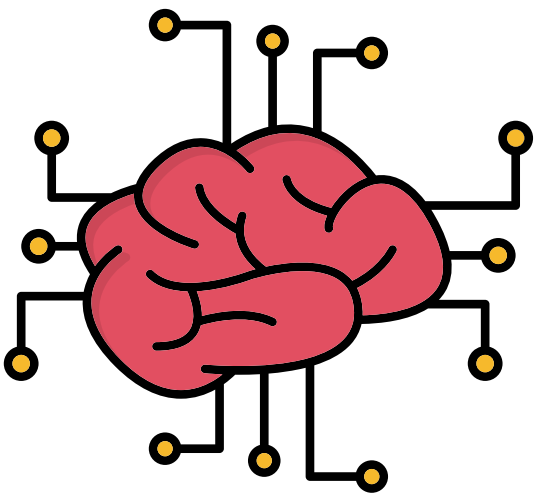
HOW DO I USE THIS IN MY CLASSROOM?

Try using this strategy as:

- Warm up exercise
- Minute paper
- Think-pair-share
- Trivia



WHEN TO USE IT?



Before introducing new concepts.

Engage learners to connect the foundational information previously learned about the topic as a starting point to build out understanding the new content.

WHY USE IT?

Promotes learners to make connections to material. This brings to the front of the mind what information they already know to make meaningful connections to the new information.
