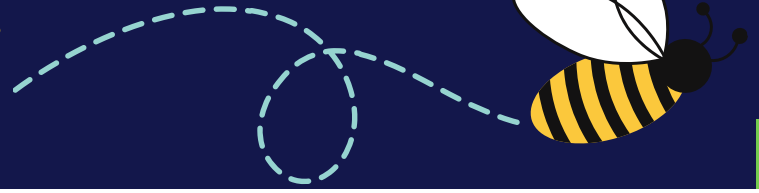

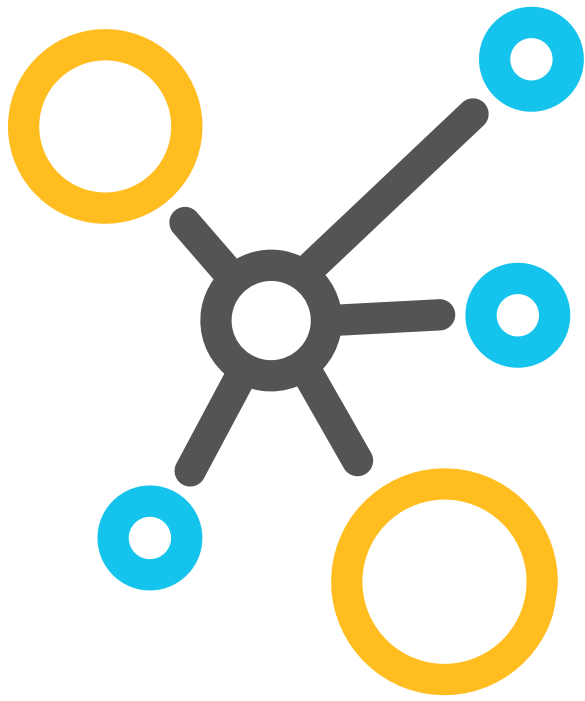

SCHEMA



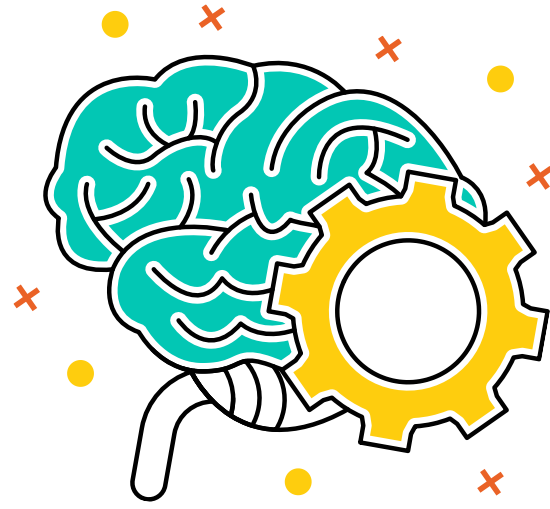
Assimilating concepts by analyzing the material through describing, categorizing, and organizing the material in the context of previous knowledge so it makes sense.

HOW DO I USE THIS IN MY CLASSROOM?

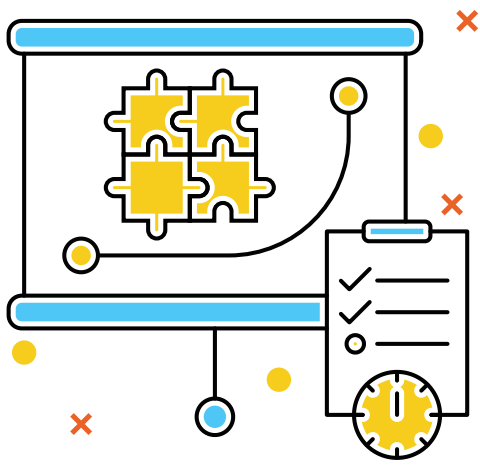
Model Schemas & Foster Practice with:

- Concept maps
- Brainstorming
- Activate Prior Knowledge

Learners use sticky notes to physically construct an organizational structure of the information.



WHEN TO USE IT?



When learners are presented with novel concepts.

Stop during the lesson and purposefully provide the connections. Do not assume the learners can make the connections themselves.

Think aloud, and share how these concepts connect.

WHY USE IT?

Provides an efficient framework to understand, retain and retrieve content in meaningful ways.
