



# SCAFFOLDING



Deliver content in increasingly complex learning "chunks" while removing those learning chunks, or scaffolding, as learner gains competency and progresses.

## WHEN TO USE IT?



When introducing a new concept.


- Present information at a level just beyond what the learners currently understand.
- Provide multiple formats and opportunities for learners to explore the information, generate connections, and practice retrieval meaningfully.

### **HOW DO I USE THIS IN MY COURSE?**


Provide learners with "think time" within the session.

- Fishbowl Activity,
- Think-pair-share,
- Turn and talk,
- Triad teams



#### WHY USE IT?
