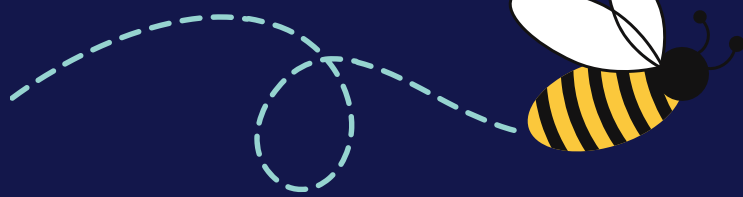

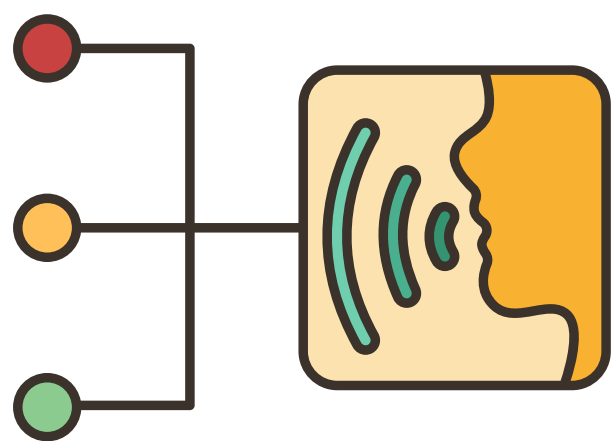


Buzzwords in Education Explained

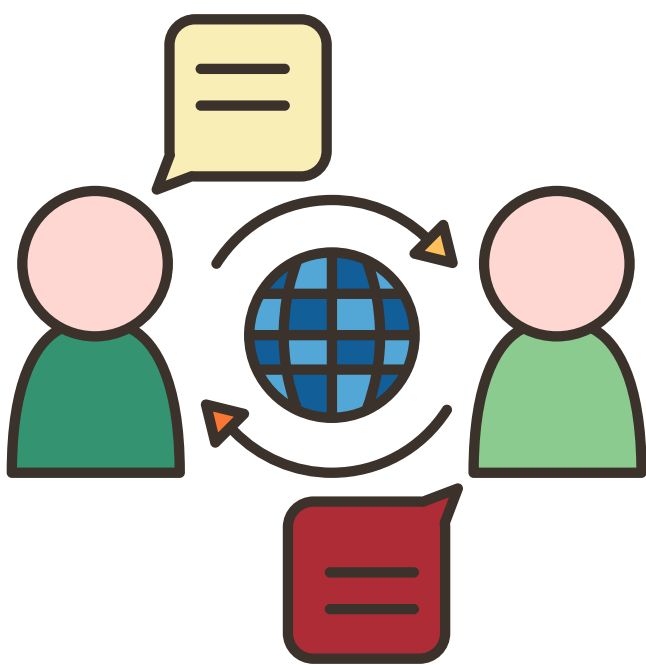
Dive in! Examine popular teaching approaches. Discover how to apply the strategy and eliminate misconceptions about these trending buzzwords.

Interactions or behaviors that occur often, are subtle, can be (un)intentional, and reinforce negative bias toward a historically marginalized group.



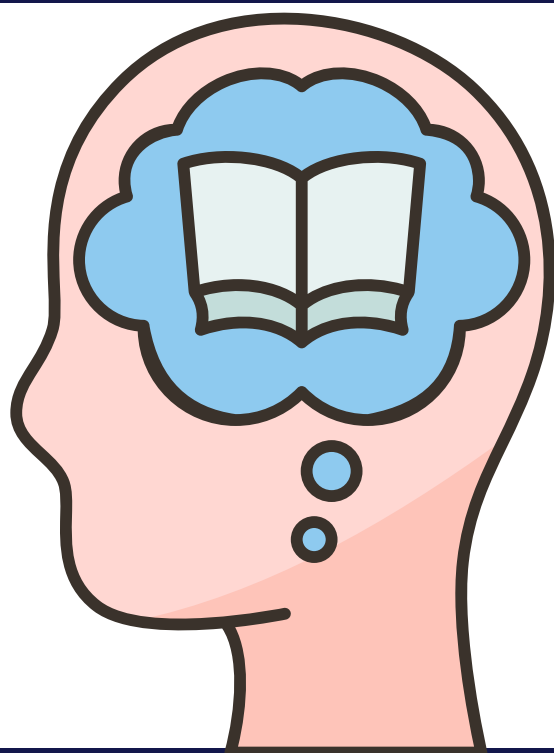
WHEN TO USE IT?



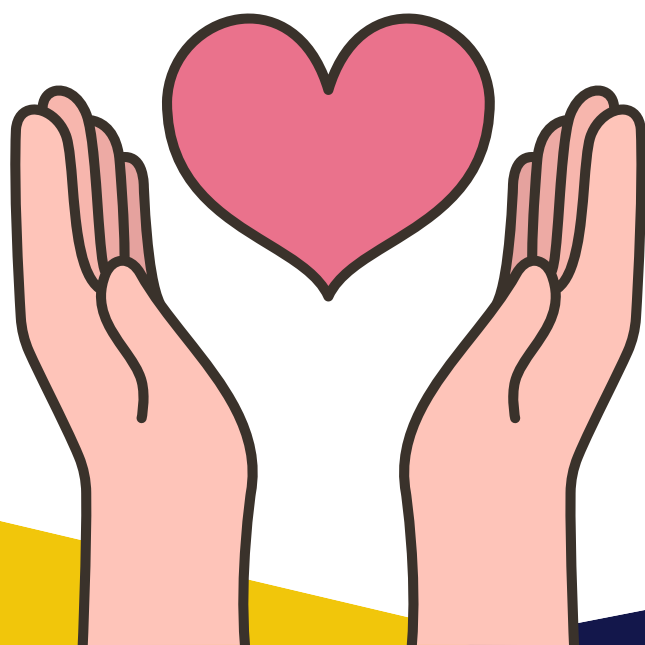
If you catch yourself performing a microaggression, immediately stop and acknowledge it with a sincere apology. If you are the recipient of a microaggression, and feel safe doing so, say something.

HOW DO I USE THIS IN MY CLASSROOM?

Take some time to learn about microaggressions; you may be inadvertently hurting groups who feel unable to speak up. Simply being aware of and working to avoid microaggressions is a great start. Level up by specifically asking learners and peers to call you out if you say or do something harmful.
