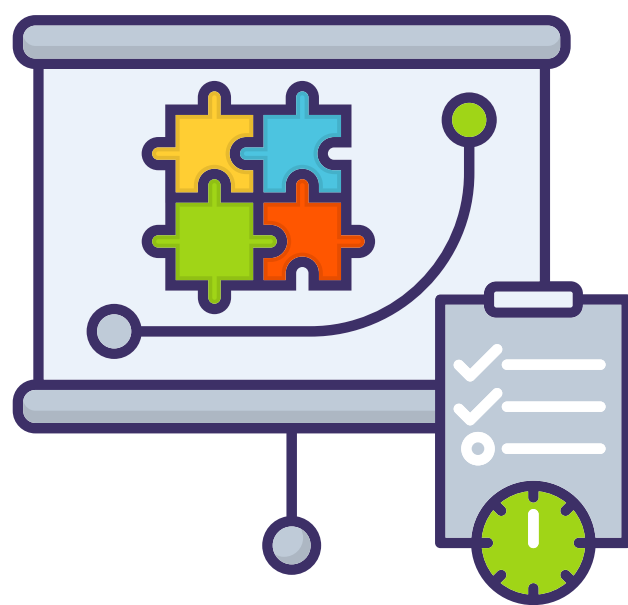
TESTING EFFECT



Working to actively recall information (testing oneself) creates long-term memories than simply reading.

WHEN TO USE IT?

Frequently, and any time you want to encourage students to solidify information and strengthen recall.



HOW DO I USE THIS IN MY CLASSROOM?



During Class: Give short pre/post tests when introducing new material.

Outside of Class: Encourage students to use flashcards or quizzes as part of their study strategies

WHY USE IT?

Testing strengthens neural networks and solidifies the path to retrieve information, making knowledge more stable and easily accessible. Even in high-stress situations like tests or classroom discussions!
