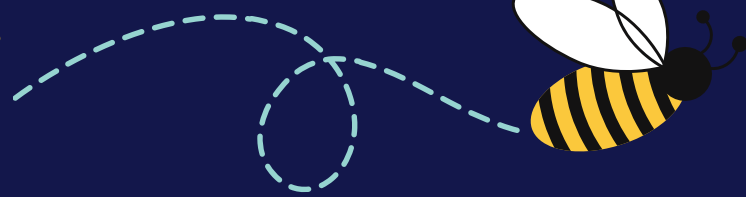

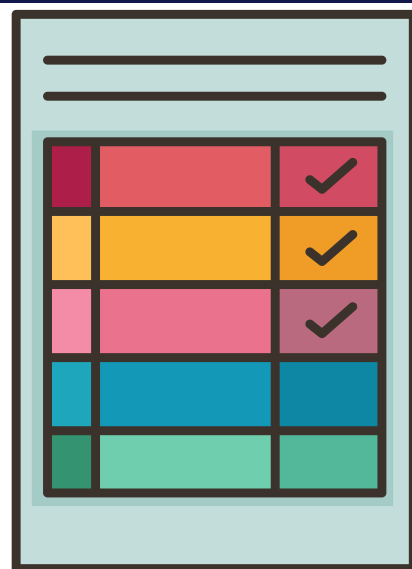


Buzzwords in Education Explained

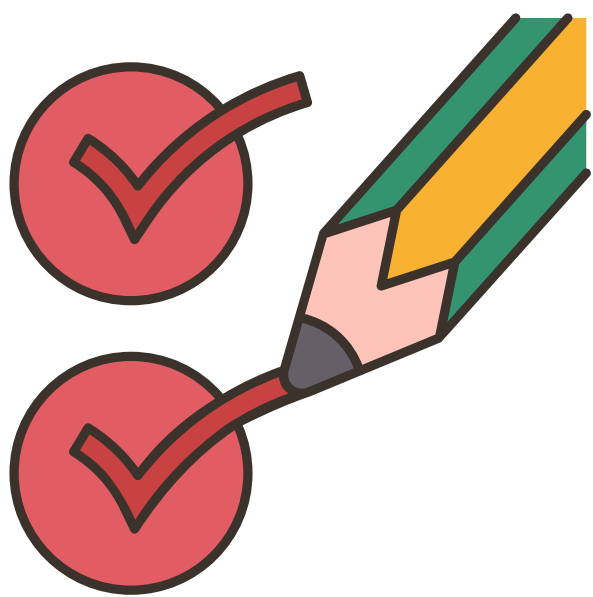
Dive in! Examine popular teaching approaches. Discover how to apply the strategy and eliminate misconceptions about these trending buzzwords.

WHEN TO USE IT?



Share learning outcomes at the start of every course and every class. Learners should know what they are expected to be able to demonstrate after your time together.

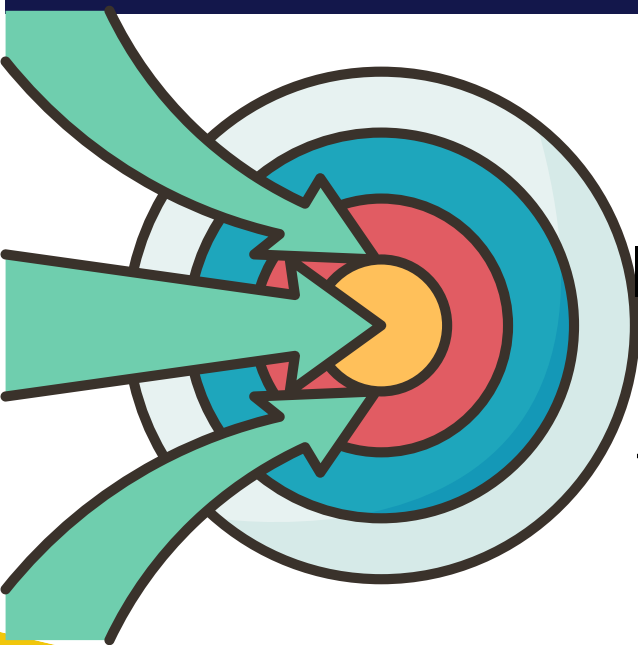
HOW DO I USE THIS IN MY CLASSROOM?

As a guide for what learners will be expected to achieve. Remember to keep objectives/outcomes

SMART – **S**pecific,
Measurable, **A**chievable,
Relevant, and **T**imely!



WHY USE IT?



Focusing on objectives/outcomes means that the learner and the instructor both clearly understand the goals for the session and whether or not they have been achieved.
